MYTH TIME OF YEAR

Just in time for the holiday season is someone coming out with a theory undermining Christianity. It's an oldy-moldy tactic. An archeologist along with a co-perpetrator is claiming they found a "lost" gospel. This so-called lost gospel asserts Christ was married and had children. In the 16th century Spain was the superpower of its day. (Stamp, 1994) Spain had colonies in Central America and a large part of South America. It also controlled parts of Europe. The Spanish Empire was seen as a threat to many countries in Europe especially in the areas where the Protestant Reformation occurred. In order to rally against Spain the propaganda war began. One area was the Spanish Inquisition. The propagandists let people to believe that the Spanish Catholic Church was out of control torturing people, burning witches at the stake, and indulging in other barbaric acts. Nothing could be further from the truth. There were specific rules for the Inquisition to follow. Torture was not used haphazardly if it was used at all. THE THEATINE MONASTIC ORDER

The Theatine Monastic Order began in the 16th century A.D. (Fish Eaters, 2014) The Order is also known as the "Clerics Regular". The purpose of this Order was to educate the clergy and the laity against the errors of the Protest Reformation. The Theatine Order founded communities throughout the world. There is also a Second Order founded under Venerable Ursula Benincasa later in the 16th century. The Second Order is dedicated to an austere lifestyle of St. Martha.

Four men founded the Theatine Order. (Ragonesi, 1912) They were Gaetano dei Conti di Tiene, Paolo Consiglieri, Bonifacio da Colle, and Giovanni Pietro Carafa. Later, Giovanni Pietro Carafa became Pope Paul IV in 1555 A.D. This Order took its name from the city it was founded in, Chieti, or in English, Theate. The founders dedicated the Theate Order to the Cross. The Cross is also the symbol for this Order. The Church formally recognized the Theate Order on June 24, 1524 A.D. under Pope Clement VII.

The Theate Order began to grow and spread throughout the Italian peninsula. (Ragonesi, 1912) Numerous oratories and hospitals can trace their origins to the Theate Order. Eventually the Theate Order went to foreign countries to start papal missions. One mission of note is the Theate community in Armenia. The Armenian Church severed relations with the west in the 6th century A.D. Father Galano of the Theate Order while in Armenia wrote a history of the Armenian Church. Through his work and dedication he ended the schism between the Armenian Church and Rome. Unfortunately, after many centuries of growth the Theate Order experienced a decline in the 19th century A.D.

In recent history Pope Pius X stemmed the decline of the Theate Order. He merged the Theate Order with the Spanish Congregation of the Holy Family at Barcelona in the early 20th century A.D. (Ragonesi, 1912) Today the Theater Order has a prominent presence in Colorado. The Order maintains numerous parishes and schools. More information can be found at: Theatine Fathers Our Lady of Purity http://theatinesusa.com/home.html. Like many monastic order the Theate Order also has a Second Order.

Venerable Ursula Benincasa founded the Second Order in the late 16th century A.D. (Ragonesi, 1912) The name Venerable Ursula Benincasa called the Second Order is the Sisters of the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin Mary. She dedicated the Second Order to the Rosary. One distinguishing characteristic of the Second Order is its Blue Scapular. Venerable Ursula Benincasa instituted the Blue Scapular which is still worn by the Second Order today.
